This year we will once again be offering **Team Cheers!** in our **Western Region & State Tournament programs**.....and hopefully help your team raise a little money for an end of year party! A **Team Cheers!** is an ad wishing a team, school, team member, coach, judge, or district good luck. Here's the way it works...

Register Your Teams for Your Regional Tournament....

Included with this newsletter is the **Western** Region team registration form, which must be completed and returned by **2/1/07**. On this form you will be asked to submit the names of each team member and Team Manager competing at the Western Regional Tournament. Please be sure to write, or type the form as legibly as possible as this is the source from which Certificates of Participation and program acknowledgments come. You will also be *required* to submit the name and contact information for at least one individual willing to be trained and Appraise at the tournament (see article "Membership Requirement" in this issue). *No team will be scheduled until they provide the name of a volunteer!* Team Registration Form on last page fill this form out and return it to Dee Urban, Director CHECK WITH YOUR REGIONAL DIRECTOR FOR REGISTRATION INFORMATION IN THE EASTERN AND CENTRAL REGIONS.

This requirement is being instituted across NY State this year in order to provide our teams with the best possible Appraisal teams at all tournaments. We want **all** of our wonderful teams to feel that our Appraisal teams are well balanced. Appraisers can be any adult (over the age of 18 years) and out of High School. A sample Appraiser recruitment letter is included with the Appraiser form at the end of this newsletter.

Clarifications....

REMEMBER clarifications are updated at the DI Web-site (http://www.idodi.org/clarifications.php) regularly! Check for new clarifications daily by going to our NY home page (www.nydi.org) and clicking on "link to National Clarifications". There are currently clarifications for **Direct Flight** & **Switching TraDItions** Team Challenges! Make it a habit to check for new clarifications once a week. Below are the current Published Clarifications as of 12/4/06:

Challenge A - DIrect Flight

Section	Clarification
N/A	Test Flight Cards can be downloaded here for team use while practicing.
	Click here to download (PDF)
A.3.a.ii	A.3.a.ii permits an Aircraft to physically contact the Elevator that Released it during the Test Flight. Any physical contact with this Elevator after the Aircraft is Released can only be incidental and cannot increase the score received by the Aircraft for the Test Flight.
A.1, Special	Replace the definition of Aircraft in section A.1, Special Definitions with:
Definitions	Aircraft: A machine or device that uses some method(s) of controlled descent in its movement through the air. During a Test Flight one or more features on the Aircraft itself must contribute to increasing the time spent in the air.
	The increased time in the air must be easily observed by the Appraisers. Teams should be prepared to explain to the Appraisers the feature(s) on the Aircraft that contribute to slowing its descent.
	For example: The wings on a paper airplane cause its time in the air to actually increase over a plane without any wings. On the other hand, a beanbag launched by a catapult is not an Aircraft. Its time in the air is controlled by the force of the catapult and not increased by any feature on the beanbag. An arrow or rocket also typically doesn't meet our definition of an Aircraft. The fins or feathers on these devices are designed to make them fly cleanly through the air rather than slow their descent.

Challenge D - Switching TraDItions

Section	Clarification
A.10.a.ii.	In the NOTE: Any words and pictures already commercially printed on any items are acceptable, but pre- printed words and pre-printed pictures may not be incorporated in any manner into the Skit.
	Printed or woven patterns or pictures on fabric are subject to the same rules as pre-printed words and picture as stated in the NOTE in Section A.10.a.ii.
