

TURNER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

This Scholarship will be awarded in recognition and celebration of Lorry and Roy Turner's lives and dedication to Destination Imagination of NY, Inc (NYDI). It is the intention of the NYDI Board of Trustees that this scholarship honor those who *inspire* others to participate and who *contribute by their action* to NYDI by giving of themselves with joy and grace for the betterment of our program. Participating on a team in Destination Imagination (DI) is just the beginning of the journey. This scholarship recognizes those participants who inspire others to engage in the creative process by applying what they have learned within their community.

Eligibility

Current DI participants who are High School Juniors or Seniors or DI Alumni currently enrolled in College or Post Secondary Education, may be awarded a scholarship based upon their demonstrated commitment and service (volunteered time and effort) to NYDI and creative problem solving. Applications will be evaluated without regard for financial need, GPA, gender, age, citizenship, sexual preference, or ethnicity. Applicants must be actively involved in NYDI. Winners will be announced at the NYDI Affiliate tournament, April 7, 2018, which all applicants are encouraged to attend.

Application Requirements

(incomplete applications will not be considered for this award)

1. Submit this application form (pages 2 and 3), completed and signed by the applicant (and by parent / guardian if applicant is under 18 years old).

2. Submit a short essay, no longer than 1200 words, describing who the applicant believes they have inspired; include in the narrative a description of when and how the applicant influenced the individual/group.

3. Submit two brief letters that confirm the applicant's inspiration and contribution to the DI Program. Neither letter may be from a close relative. One letter must be from someone who has personal knowledge of the applicant's participation in DI. The other letter should be from a person who knows the applicant from school or from a non-DI extracurricular activity. **Both letters must specifically address HOW the applicant has inspired others to engage in creative problem solving.**

Requested, but not a requirement: Please submit a head and shoulders photograph of the applicant.

Winners will be selected based upon their demonstrated commitment and service to NYDI and creative team-based problem solving, and the content of their letters of reference. Winners will be notified before the NYDI Affiliate Tournament.

An acknowledgement of receipt of application will be emailed to the applicant. Only one application may be tendered per applicant. Applicants may receive the scholarship only once, but an applicant who has not yet received a scholarship may continue applying in future years, subject to the above criteria. NYDI reserves the right to reject any application for any reason, and is not obligated to issue any awards.
